

# **CASE WORKER**

## **SUMMARY**

#### **JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

#### A. PREVENTION

- o Participate in internal training and create training manuals for volunteers.
- Conduct focus groups with community members
- Train local leaders (volunteers) on child protection, gender-based violence, and case management
- Help organize radio talk shows and further trainings about relevant topics surrounding prevention
- Suggest and facilitate creative ways for community engagement in the project

## **B. CASE MANAGEMENT**

- Work with the case desk attendant to respond to cases promptly.
- Advise survivors/ family of survivors on required steps to resolve the case.
- Accompany survivor to proper authorities
- Work alongside authorities, government organs, and other partners.
- Coordinate logistics, with case desk attendant, for survivor to meet all legal requirements for a case
- Keep precise documentation of all events, evidence, and documents along the process
- Monitor the safety and well-being of survivors and their families
- o Assist with mental health concerns, behavioral concerns, and positive behavioral support
- o Provide counseling services as needed with survivors and their families
- Conduct home visits in scheduled intervals

#### C. REPORTING

- Prepare narrative reports/ impact reports on how survivors and their families are responding to the process and subsequent counseling. Include pictures and videos
- o Create a weekly action plan at least the Friday before the following work week
- Keep record of daily activities (site visits, counseling sessions, etc.) and share with the Ignite Change team each week
- Participate in continuous staff professional development and activities for learning and idea generation
- o Create purchase requests as needed for needed materials for have successful programs

The above list of job duties and responsibilities is not exhaustive. Additional duties and responsibilities may be added at any time.
