- o Provide feedback on lessons and activities
- Maintain current students' attendance records
- o Ensure that safety precautions are observed during training activities
- o Carry out data collection/ documentation as required
- Prepare reports as required
- o Provide entrepreneurship and business skill training to learners
- Provide market information and technical support that includes linking the graduates of the program to employment opportunities
